When Ola's S1 Pro scooters faced thermal runaway issues in 2024, Amara Raja's phase-change material cooling system reduced battery temps by 15°C during fast charging. The result? A 3-year exclusive supply contract worth INR420 crore.

The Localization Hurdle

Why's localization crucial for India's energy future? Consider this:

Import duties on cells: 15%

Local production incentives: 5% PLI subsidy

Transport cost savings: INR3.2/km for battery logistics

Amara Raja's playing 4D chess here. Their tech transfer model avoids IP lawsuits while achieving 64% local content in battery packs - a first for India.

Future-Proofing Energy Storage

As India's renewable capacity hits 225GW in 2025, Amara Raja's 500MWh solar-plus-storage project in Andhra Pradesh becomes a blueprint. Their containerized 2MWh battery systems reduced diesel genset usage by 83% at Hyderabad's IT corridor.
