Three words: batteries, brains, and bureaucracy. Lithium-ion battery prices dropped 18% year-on-year, but import duties on Chinese inverters jumped 7.5% last quarter. Here's what's shaping prices:

- Smart features like load prioritization

1. Demand component breakdowns - Good installers separate inverter, battery, and labor costs
2. Check certification against South African Bureau of Standards (SABS) lists
3. Compare warranty terms - 10 years on parts vs. 5 years makes a huge difference
4. Ask about software update costs
5. Verify installer credentials with the South African Photovoltaic Industry Association

A Bloemfontein client nearly fell for a "R99,900 complete system" that used refurbished batteries. We found them a certified 8kW system with new components for R87,400. Moral of the story? Due diligence pays.

While everyone debates Eskom's future, smart homeowners are creating microgrids. In Knysna, 40 households now trade solar power through peer-to-peer energy sharing enabled by advanced inverters. This isn't sci-fi - it's using existing tech to bypass traditional energy models entirely.

But here's the catch: Early adopters benefit most. Government tax incentives covering 25% of installation costs expire December 2025. Combine that with the rand's instability against Chinese manufacturing currencies, and delaying could cost you thousands.

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
