Does It Actually Work?

Take the Muller family in Stuttgart. After installing 15kW Mercedes storage with existing panels:

Grid dependence dropped from 60% to 12%

Monthly bills fell from EUR210 to EUR38

Surplus energy sold back earned EUR610/year

But here's the kicker - during December's grid outage, their Christmas lights stayed on while neighbors froze. The system automatically isolated their home into an energy island, prioritizing fridge and heating circuits.
