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Lithium-ion technology now achieves 95% round-trip efficiency, compared to lead-acid's 80%. That means for every 10kW your solar panels produce, you keep 9.5kW usable energy instead of 8kW.

Choosing Your Solar Storage: 3 Key Considerations

When the Van der Merwe family installed their 10kWh system last spring, they learned three crucial lessons:

Depth of Discharge (DoD): Never drain batteries below 20% capacity

Cyclic Lifespan: Quality lithium batteries endure 6,000+ charge cycles

Scalability: Start with 5kW but leave room for future expansion

The Battery Size Sweet Spot

For most Bedford View homes, installer Thabo Mbeki recommends:

"Aim for 2 days of autonomy. If you use 10kWh daily, install 20kWh storage. This handles consecutive cloudy days without grid reliance."

Bedford View Homes Powered by Solar Batteries

The O.R. Tambo Precinct now runs entirely on solar + storage, slashing municipal energy costs by R4.2 million annually. On the residential front, retiree Gert van Ryn eliminated his electricity bill while powering:
