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regular glass. The secret? Quantum dot technology that harvests UV and infrared light while letting visible light through. It's already cutting energy bills by 40% for early adopters.

When Solar Meets Sichuan Peppercorns

Let's get real with a case study from Luzhou. Farmer Zhang upgraded to a 3kW system last autumn, powering his chili-drying racks and WeChat livestreams. The kicker?
